Control and Reporting Centre (CRC) Karmelava, LTU



The Combined CRC Karmelava has been operating since January 2007. It has replaced the Regional Airspace Surveillance and Control Centre. The CRC was established by joint agreement of the Estonia, Latvia, and Lithuania and is a part of the NATO Integrated Air Defence System (NATINADS).

The main responsibilities of CRC Karmelava are to provide Recognised Air Picture (RAP) and to control NATO air policing fighters over Estonia, Latvia, and Lithuania.

The CRC functions are carried out by a total of 47 staff from Estonia, Latvia and Lithuania. Baltic fighter controllers also provide control of the Baltic Air Policing mission.

The national Lithuanian Control and Reporting Post (CRP) is collocated with the CRC in the facilities at Karmelava.
