### NATO Baltic Region Training Event III

10 July 2009

**RAMSTEIN-MIESENBACH, Germany — NATO units from the Czech Republic, Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, and the United States Air Forces in Europe (USAFE) as well as a contractor aircraft will conduct air defence training within established tactics, techniques and procedures of the NATO Integrated Air Defence System (NATINADS) in the airspace above the three Baltic NATO member countries on 14 and 15 July 2009.**

The focus of this training event is on combined air policing and air defence enhancing air interoperability between Estonia, Latvia and Lithuania, and other NATO countries. During the training event standard peacetime operating procedures apply.

The training is embedded in the annual NATO Electronic Warfare Force Integration Programme (NEWFIP) to allow aircrews to train under realistic Electronic Warfare (EW) conditions. Control and Reporting Centre (CRC) at Karmelava, Lithuania, and the Control and Reporting Post (CRP) at Ämari, Estonia, will be controlling the training activities.

In the afternoon of 14 July, a USAFE C-130 transport aircraft is planned to conduct an aerial delivery at a training range near Nurmsi airfield southwest of Tallinn, Estonia. Weather permitting the aerial delivery of a training pallet is planned for 3 to 3.30 p.m. The aircraft will then land at Tallinn International Airport, where the media will have a chance to meet a NATO spokesperson, the C-130 aircrew and their aircraft on the ground for questions from 4.30 p.m. on.
