BIOGRAPHY

Brigadier General Hakan Evrim Deputy Chief of Staff Plans

Brigadier General Hakan EVRİM was assigned as the Deputy Chief of Staff Plans, Headquarters Allied Air Command effective 1 December 2012.

In 1984 General EVRİM joined the Turkish Air Force (TURAF) as an air cadet. After completing his pilot training he served as an F-4E fighter pilot in several squadrons of 7th Main Jet Base in Malatya. He attended conversion training to the F-16 and combat readiness training at Tucson International AFB Arizona, USA, in 1996. Upon his return to Turkey he was assigned to 191 Squadron, 9th Main Jet Base at Balıkesir as an F-16 fighter pilot.



After graduating from Air War College in 2000 he served as a Personnel Career Planning Officer at the HQ TURAF Personnel Department and was posted to the Air Education and Training Command HQ in San Antonio-Texas, USA, as a Turkish Exchange Officer.

From 2004 to 2007, he was assigned to HQ TURAF in Ankara as a staff officer in the Personnel Course Planning Section and, subsequently, in the Plans and Policy Division as a member of an advisory team to the Commander TURAF, responsible for preparing and producing advice for National Security Council meetings.

In 2007 General Evrim became commander of 143rd Squadron at 4th Main Jet Base and, subsequently, attended a joint operations course at the Armed Forces Staff College. In 2008 he was assigned as Head of the Personnel Planning Branch in TUR AF HQ Personnel, Planning and Management Department.

In 2010 he was appointed as the Operations Group Commander of the 4th Main Jet Base Command which focuses on the basic F-16 fighter training for both national and international participants.

Promoted to Brigadier General in 2012 he became the Turkish Air Force Deputy Chief of the Planning and Policy Division, advising Commander TURAF on Turkish national security policy issues.

Brigadier General Hakan EVRİM and his wife F. İlknur have two children, İlhan and Canan.
