NATO AWACS and USA C-130 aircraft at Šiauliai

Ramstein, 22 October. On 3 November 2010, Headquarters Allied Air Command Ramstein (HQ AC Ramstein) will again conduct a training event to demonstrate Alliance cohesion and reassurance at Šiauliai Air Base, Lithuania. The seventh Baltic Region Training Event (BRTE) in the airspace above Estonia, Latvia and Lithuania is an opportunity to see a USA C-130J Hercules transport aircraft conduct a tactical off-load, USA F-15C Eagle fighter aircraft take-off and a NATO Airborne Warning and Control System (AWACS) Boeing 707 touch down at Šiauliai Air Base.

A media event is scheduled at Šiauliai Air Base from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. on 3 November. Media representatives will have an opportunity to get first-hand information about the BRTE VII event, to talk to NATO commanders and aircrews and to take pictures or video footage of the activities on the day. For that purpose the local Lithuanian military authorities will establish a press point.

Interested media representatives are asked to fill in the attached form and send it to Captain Agnė Liberė, Šiauliai Air Base at agne.libere@mil.lt for registration not later than 1 November 2010. Further details will be provided in response to the accreditation form.

No transport to Šiauliai can be offered and the actual flying missions during the training event will not be visible from the ground. Therefore, HQ AC Ramstein will upload material and B-footage for media representatives at www.airn.nato.int after the event.
