### Brunssum's Command Sergeant Majors meet

Related to the last Joint Force Command Brunssum Commanders Conference, the Command Sergeant Major of the Joint Forces Command Brunssum and the three Command Sergeant Majors from the subordinate Component Commands (Air, Land and Maritime) have met for their 4<sup>th</sup> Conference.

Chief Warrant Officer Mario Ouellet from Brunssum, Warrant Officer Coxun George Fenwick for the Maritime Component Northwood, Oberstabsfeldwebel Michael Jordan from CC-Land Heidelberg and Warrant Officer Oscar De Mauro for CC-Air attended and represented the Non-commissioned Officers (NCO) of their respective headquarters. They were welcomed by the host, WO De Mauro. Also Chief Master Sergeant Martin Klukas, the Command Chief of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Air Force, based at Ramstein Air Base, attend the meeting.

After a common conference part together with General Ramms and the Component commanders where they got information about the JFC Brunssum related main topics, the NCO representatives joined their own meeting. Their main subject was the development of a proposal to implement a NATO NCO training. A new created Joint Mobile Training Team (JMTT) has already took over the responsibility for that. CWO Ouellet illustrated the improvements that this itinerant team of instructors already had achieved. Several NATO and PfP countries like Slovakia, Lithuania, Latvia and Croatia have already been visited more than once – with great feedback. Another option for NCO training is the NATO NCO Orientation Course, provided by the NATO School in Oberammergau.

Further steps in developing the NCO training like exchange within the instructor pool were discussed in order to provide well trained and professional NCOs for best results and service in a complex military headquarters environment.
